### **Scholarships for entry into Year 7 at Quinton House School**

I am delighted to inform you that the details for our scholarship programme for entry into Year 7 in September 2019 are now available on our website at [www.quintonhouseschool.co.uk/admissions-fees/scholarships-bursaries/](http://www.quintonhouseschool.co.uk/admissions-fees/scholarships-bursaries/).

Scholarships are first and foremost a public celebration of a pupil's achievement. In awarding a scholarship, Quinton House School will support the scholar in the continuous pursuit of excellence within their specialist field, and, where applicable, liaise with external agencies to further support the pupil's progress in the scholarship area.

Quinton House School celebrates pupils with a broad range of talents and skills and we recognise and reward outstanding talent across the curriculum. We therefore award scholarships in academia, drama, music and sport. We also offer all-rounder awards for those pupils who are able to contribute significantly to the Quinton House School community in a number of different fields.

Pupils awarded a scholarship will be entitled to a reduction in fees of up to 25%. This will be applied for the duration of the student's time in the Senior School. We are now inviting applications for scholarships and our application process is as follows:

#### **Friday 11th January**

#### **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> January**

Internal candidate interviews for Sport and Performing Arts Scholarships will be held during the week beginning Monday 14<sup>th</sup> January.

#### **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> January**

Internal candidates for Academic and All-round Scholarships Interviews.

#### **Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> January**

All pupils wishing to be considered for an academic or all-rounder scholarship are required to sit two scholarship examinations, one in English and one in mathematics. These examinations will last 1 hour each, with a break between them. Pupils will be required arrive at the Main Entrance at Upton Hall at 9.15 am and the examinations will be over by 12.15 pm when the pupils should be collected.

Any pupil wishing to apply for either a Sports or a Performing Arts Scholarship is requested to submit a portfolio for assessment and to attend an interview. Performing Arts applicant will be required to undertake a practical

performance overseen by the Head of Music or Head of Drama. Sports Scholarship applicants will be asked to undertake a practical assessment overseen by the Director of Sport, which will include baseline fitness testing.

Scholarship awards are published and parents are invited to make an appointment to meet with the Headmaster to discuss the results.
