### **Scholarships for entry into Year 7, Year 9 and Sixth Form at Quinton House School**

I am delighted to inform you that the details for our scholarship programme for entry into Year 7, Year 9 and Year 12 in September 2020 are now available on our website at [www.quintonhouseschool.co.uk/admissions-fees/scholarships-bursaries/](http://www.quintonhouseschool.co.uk/admissions-fees/scholarships-bursaries/).

Scholarships are first and foremost a public celebration of a students' achievement. In awarding a scholarship, Quinton House School will support the scholar in the continuous pursuit of excellence within their specialist field, and, where applicable, liaise with external agencies to further support the students' progress in the scholarship area.

Quinton House School celebrates students with a broad range of talents and skills, and we recognise and reward outstanding talent across the curriculum. We therefore award scholarships in academia, drama, music and sport. We also offer all-rounder awards for those students who are able to contribute significantly to the Quinton House School community in a number of different fields.

Students awarded a scholarship will be entitled to a reduction in fees of up to 25%. This will be applied for the duration of the student's time in the Senior School. We are now inviting applications for scholarships and our application process is as follows:

**Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January** Please return the scholarship application form to Mrs Jo Sainsbury, Admissions Manager.

**Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> January** Internal and external candidate practical assessments for Sport, Music, Drama and Art.

**Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January**

All students wishing to be considered for an academic or all-rounder scholarship in Years 7 and 9 are required to sit two scholarship examinations, one in English and one in Mathematics. These examinations will last 1 hour each, with a break between them. Students will be required arrive at the Main Entrance at Upton Hall at 9.30 am and the examinations will be over by 12.15 pm when the students should either be collected or should return to normal lessons. There will be specific Sixth Form scholarship papers to be completed for those interested in Sixth Form.

**Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> January**

Sixth Form interviews take place with the Principal and members of the Senior Leadership Team.

Any student wishing to apply for either a Sports or a Performing Arts Scholarship is requested to submit a portfolio for assessment and to attend an interview. Performing Arts applicant will be required to undertake a practical performance overseen by the Head of Music or Head of Drama. Sports Scholarship applicants will be asked to undertake a practical assessment overseen by the Director of Sport, which will include baseline fitness testing.

**Week beginning Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January**

Scholarship awards are published, and parents are invited to make an appointment to meet with the Principal to discuss the results.
